We will ensure that the information that was missing will be in the system for the next submission. At this time, we do not believe that there will be financial implication. However, it is unknown how we will be affected. After consulting with county officials, state officials, auditors and our student information system consultants; this was determined to be a human error, as a report did not post in CALPADS during the fall reporting window. Protocols will be put in place to ensure that this will not reoccur.
